

The 2018 Lincoln Homecoming will Recognize the 50th Anniversary of Lincoln-Zephyr Owners Club

The 2018 Homecoming will combine the Fifth Annual Lincoln Homecoming with the 50th Anniversary of the Lincoln-Zephyr Owners Club (LZOC). The event will be held in two locations: Elkhart, Indiana and Hickory Corners/Kalamazoo, Michigan.

The 2018 Homecoming is being hosted by the Lincoln-Zephyr Owners Club and all four Lincoln clubs are invited to attend the annual Lincoln Homecoming: Road Race Lincoln Register, Lincoln Continental Owners Club and the Lincoln Owners Club. Any Lincoln owner who is not a club member is also encouraged to register and attend this event. The 1936-1948 V-12 Lincoln-Zephyr plus pre and post-war Lincolns will be featured.

Please join us and celebrate on the rolling prairies of northern Indiana August 6-9, concluding with a Golden Jubilee Heritage bash at the Auburn-Cord-Duesenberg Automobile Museum on Thursday, August 9," said Tom Brunner, LZOC president.

On Friday, August 10, we tour to Kalamazoo to enjoy our Fifth Lincoln Homecoming at Hickory Corners on Saturday and Sunday. We will have a People's Choice All Decades Lincoln car show on Saturday, August 11, for all Lincolns. It is an exhibition show only with no point judging. The presentation of People's Choice awards will be Sunday, August 12, featuring awards for each decade—the 1920s through the 2000s; Best of Show and First, Second and Third Places will be awarded for each decade.

"Best of all," Brunner continued, "we will have luxurious motor coaches for all of our tours in Indiana. All tours will leave from the Hilton Garden Inn hotel in Elkhart, Indiana. On Tuesday, August 7, bus tour # 1 will go to South Bend and the glorious National Studebaker Museum where you will see the carriage that took President Lincoln to Ford's theatre. You will see the '36 Studebaker that looked like a '36 Zephyr, visit the Notre Dame Football Room, and see the Oliver Victorian Home that will transport you to another era. Enjoy a delightful lunch at the Victorian castle of the Studebaker family called Tippecanoe Place.

On Wednesday we will have three bus tours. Bus tour #2 will feature a Brown Bag Tour to Amish cottage industries. On bus tour # 3 you will visit the "Real Housewives of Amish Country. On bus tour #4 we will ride to Shipshewana and see the old fashioned Amish livestock and home furnishing auction. There will be plenty of good things to eat. If you choose, you may visit the Hostetler Hudson Museum on your own.

"On Thursday's bus tour #5 we will travel the route of the original 1913 Lincoln Highway through the farm country of northern Indiana, to visit the Auburn Cord Duesenberg Automobile Museum, the National Automotive and Truck Museum (NATMUS), the Early Ford V-8 Foundation's re-creation of the Ford Rotunda, and the DeKalb County courthouse. Thursday night will be our Founders Dinner and LZOC history celebration and Golden Anniversary Bash at the Auburn-Cord-Duesenberg Automobile Museum.

The number of seats on our tour buses are limited so it will be first come, first served, until rooms and tours are filled.

2018 REGISTRATION GENERAL INFORMATION (Please read carefully)

1. You do not have to participate in all activities; it's okay to pick and choose.
2. Your registration includes a place where you can purchase a Gilmore Car Museum Weekend Gate pass for \$18.00, instead of paying a daily gate fee of \$12.00.
3. LMCHF Life Members receive free access to the Gilmore—no daily gate fees—just show your LMCHF Life Member card.
4. Your LZOC membership number and expiration date is above your name on the address information on the back page of club magazine.
5. Although the hotel has a large parking area for a few trailers we prefer that you park trailers at the Gilmore, on east side of general parking, not inside the Model A gate.
6. To participate in Saturday's car show with your Lincoln you must register.
7. If you plan only to walk in and view cars and museum Saturday or Sunday without a car no registration is necessary; simply pay at entrance gate.
8. Printed Event Tickets will be used for most Elkhart and Kalamazoo/Hickory Corners activities; they will be in your meet registration packet. Wristbands will be used for Hickory Corners Gate entrance tickets; they will be in your registration packet.
9. A hose and bucket will be available at the host hotel for car washing. Bring your own supplies.
10. Car Auction details - Car must be owned by member and have clear title. Sale is between seller and buyer. Car may have a reasonable reserve. Auction fee of \$250.00 must be paid before being listed for auction. Fee is paid by seller, who must be a registered meet participant. Car may be brought to Gilmore after 5 p.m. Friday and must be removed by 6 p.m. Sunday.
11. Vendor Swap - 12' x 30' space is \$30.00 and a onetime \$20.00 registration fee per person. Setup may be done after 5 p.m. Friday and must be removed by 6 p.m. Sunday.
12. Car Corral Space - Lincolns only and must be 2000 or older. 12' X 30' space is \$30.00; space with car on trailer 12 x 40" is \$50.00 and onetime \$20.00 fee per person. Car may be brought to Gilmore after 5 p.m. Friday and must be removed by 6 p.m. Sunday.
13. Business card advertisement (2" x 3 ½") for meet booklet is available for \$50.00. Include business card with registration payment.
14. A fire extinguisher is required and must be placed by front left tire when on show field.
15. Open the Registration file using your Adobe Reader
16. Fill all General Information and registration information using the writable cells provided; DO NOT "SIGN" THE FORM UNTIL IT IS COMPLETE AND CHECKED FOR ERRORS. Once signed, it cannot be edited.
17. After you have signed the form, save the File using Save As, by including your name (example; TBRUNNER) to the your computer
18. Review the saved file to see if the data transferred to your new saved file and it is correct.
